FVHS Vocal Music Trip Information & Expectations

- 1. No public or private displays of affection...keep your hands to yourself.
- 2. Assigned check-in times with your chaperones must be followed strictly throughout the trip.
- 3. Departure times must be adhered to in order to stay on schedule. Be early!
- 4. School Dress Code is in force during the trip. If your attire is questionable, you will be asked to change clothes or wear something provided for you. If Mr. Tison deems any clothing inappropriate or a negative reflection upon the program, you will change immediately. This includes swim wear!
- 5. Your bags will be checked at the school/airport before we depart and may be checked periodically throughout the trip. Use discretion in packing your carry-on bags (for security reasons). Please see additional information for what is allowed on board the airplane.
- 6. Your hotel room may be checked by your chaperone at any time during trip. Rooms will be checked prior to "move-in" to insure the contents of the room are complete & in order.
- 7. Prescription medication should be checked in with your chaperone at the beginning of the trip. All drugs should be in their original containers. Any current medication conditions must be fully disclosed to Mr. Tison prior to departure.
- 8. Always travel in groups of at least 2 (3 is preferable). Enjoy getting to know some classmates that you don't know very well.
- 9. Be courteous of others regarding noise & your actions. Have fun but realize that we are not the only people on the plane, in the hotel, eating at the restaurant, etc.
- 10. Show respect for yourself, one another & everyone you come in contact with. Smile & say "thank you" often!
- 11. Wearing sunscreen 24 hours a day is HIGHLY recommended!
- 12. Do not enter the hotel room(s) of anyone except FVHS students or chaperones.
- 13. Hotel rooms are an extension of FVHS campus....all rules apply.
- 14. No excessive noise or running in the hotel. Be respectful of other guests. Sleeping on the street would not be a comfortable experience for any of us!
- 15. All hotel rooms will be cleaned before check-out. If there is physical damage, you (and your parents) assume full financial responsibility.
- 16. After curfew time, all students must be in their own, assigned rooms. Do not open your doors for anyone except Mr. Tison or a chaperone. Talking on the phone should also cease after curfew. You will need a good nights sleep!

- 19. Student may also be sent home early from trip at parent's expense depending on severity of violation.
