

CONCERT DAY INFO *Hope. Light. Love.* – Oct 12th 2016

Location Orange Coast College – Robert B. Moore Theater (2701 Fairview Rd. Costa Mesa 92628)

Directions 405 Fwy South – exit Fairview Road - South. Pass Adams, turn right on Merrimac Way and park in Lot C (corner of Fairview & Merrimac Way). Theater is located next to Lot C.

6:00 Performers (select) eat brown bag dinners on the lawn & attire changing

6:15 Doors open for Premium Patrons

(NOTE: these patrons can only save THEIR seat — no reserving additional seats)

6:30 Doors open for General Patrons

6:45 PERFORMANCE (no intermission)

Transportation All students need to have transportation arranged in order to be ON STAGE by their call time, listed above. Please allow time to find the theater, get parked and get inside for their individual choir rehearsal time on stage. Parking cost \$2 per car for full day or \$1 for 4 hours (until 10 p.m.)—CARPOOLING recommended.

Concert Attire Students should have ALL their needed concert attire for the concert. All students (except TB) must arrive dressed in tux or dresses (at least tux pants, white shirts & dresses). Students can bring small bag with shoes, etc. Only Troubadours, LPN, and BaronTones should bring their concert attire to the venue to change. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!! Full garment bags, book bags, etc. are NOT to be brought to the venue. Makeup and other “preparations” should NOT be done at the venue. Limited space backstage.

All concert uniforms should be properly prepared for performance (hemmed, jewelry, blue bow ties, proper shoes, etc). Attire must be COMPLETE in order to perform!

NO ONE will be allowed to leave OCC for any reason or with anyone, after arriving for rehearsal!

Food/H2O No food or drink is allowed in the theater. After your rehearsal time on stage, LC, CC & TB will have a break to eat outside on the grassy area in front of the auditorium. Brown bag meals should be brought by these students (LC, CC, TB only). Please take care of your trash properly once you have finished eating. TV & BC students should eat **before** they arrive at the college. Do not eat ANYWHERE in the building.

Ticket Purchase Tickets will be sold at the door beginning at 5:30. The theater opens to Premium Patrons at 6:15 and General Admission at 6:30. Individual ticket prices are \$12 PREMIUM per person at the door, \$8 GENERAL ADMISSION and \$5 for STUDENTS w/ ID and Vocal Music ALUMNI. Season Passes may also be purchased for use throughout the year (4 concerts), giving you the best savings and benefits!!! After the Fall Preview Concert, Season Passes are not available for purchase, but tickets can be bought individually at each concert.

Concert Seating

CC, LC, BC & TV will be seated in the theater during the performance. TB will have a backstage area for their “off-stage” time. Those students sitting in the audience should be quiet and respectful throughout the concert!

All students must remain at the venue for the entire concert in order to receive performance credit!

Take note of the following expectations!

1. We are guests of OCC – treat the facility with respect and do not bother anything that is not yours!
2. Be only where you are supposed to be – no exploring around campus! PERIOD.
3. Chaperones have authority—listen to them and respect and obey what they ask!
4. No food (of any kind) in the theater! Bottled water is allowed but throw away bottles when you are finished.
5. Take the initiative to keep the theater even cleaner than we found it!
6. No one leaves the college once you arrive—no exceptions! EVERYONE remains until the end of the concert!
7. Make beautiful music and have fun!
