AUDITION INFORMATION – 2017-2018

Concert Choir (advanced mixed) – Les Chanteurs (intermediate mixed) – Troubadours (advanced chamber) Trouveres (beginning girls) – Baron Choir (beginning guys) – BaronTones (advanced guys)

All students interested in Troubadours and Concert Choir must audition for the 2017-18 year. Current (2016-17) Les Chanteurs and Concert Choir do not need to audition if they will be returning to the same ensemble.

TROUBADOURS

- *Monday-Wednesday, May 8, 9, 10* All students auditioning 1st round for Troubadours 2 5 p.m. slots Will include *vocalization* (warm up), *solo performance*, *tonal memory* with Director.
- Wednesday, May 17 Callbacks posted by 7 a.m. sign up for a solo time later the same afternoon. 3 4:30 p.m. Students in 2nd round will come individually, after school, nicely dressed, warmed up and ready to perform their full solo (at least 2 pages of music) for the Director and Vocal Staff.
- *Friday, May 19* Callbacks posted by 7 a.m. and are for the full group to report to the Choir Room at 3:00 that afternoon for a **final round**, *group audition*. Working rehearsal in 4-part sections...will include work on sight reading, intonation, blend, balance, vowel unification, diction, etc. This part of the audition will be observed by a panel and select Senior Troubadours. Auditions will conclude by 5:30 p.m. that day and final results posted within 3 weeks time.

TROUB membership will be approx. 28 singers (depending on auditions), primarily grades 10-12.

CONCERT CHOIR

May 15, 16, 17 Sign up for time slot in Room 307. Auditions available from 2:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. each day. See schedule for specific time slots. Each audition will be with Director and will include *vocalization* (warm up), *short solo performance* and *tonal memory*.

CONCERT CHOIR membership will be comprised of approx. 75 singers, primarily grades 10-12 with priority given to those students with one-year experience in the Vocal Music Program (including FVS).

LES CHANTEURS

June 7, 8 Sign up for time slot in Room 307. Auditions available in classes and from 2 - 4 p.m.

LES CHANTS membership unlimited, consisting of girls and guys, primarily grades 10-12.

Vocalization/warm-up—to determine vocal range, strength, color of voice and other characteristics.

Solo prepared piece—preferably classical, but definitely a piece that demonstrates your vocal range, projection and style of your voice (prefer NO Pop, Disney, etc although some Broadway pieces are OK)—preferably memorized—a cappella or accompanied, and preferably in a foreign language (increases your chances for Troubadours).

Tonal memory—a series of approx 5 notes (played twice), then you sing back the pitches/rhythm on 'la' (3-5 examples of increasing difficulty).

Sight-reading—students will chose from various rhythm & melodic examples to demonstrate sight-reading proficiency and understanding. Examples will range from quite easy to more difficult.

Be EARLY to your audition time. Come with your audition sheets and information already signed and completed where appropriate. It is highly suggested that you are already partially warmed-up for the audition. Do NOT miss your audition time!

VOCALIZATION—a warm-up to help determine the range of your voice (high and low) and the quality and color (breathy, nasal, throaty, pure, soft, strong, etc)

SOLO OPTIONS—you will find suggested musical selections on the website:

These songs are *OPTIONS* **if you have trouble choosing a song.** Choose the solo for your range, learn the notes and rhythms from the REHEARSAL track and you will PERFORM to accompaniment in audition. See youtube links for extra listening help... NOTE: DO NOT SING with youtube links as the "key" may be different!!!

*You may use a solo of your own choosing. You may sing a cappella, with accompaniment CD (no karaoke please) or with piano (bring sheet music so Mr. Tison can play the piece)

The only specifications regarding a piece of your choosing is that it SHOWS OFF WHAT YOU CAN DO! "Belting" Broadway or Disney tunes or giving an "American Idol" or Brittany Spears imitation does not necessarily present your best sound for audition into an advanced classical choir. Choose carefully!

TONAL MEMORY— examples of tonal memory are played on a track for you to get an idea of this process. You may not sing or hum along, LISTEN ONLY, two times through, then sing back the pitches and rhythm on 'la.'

FORMS are REQUIRED – bring appropriate and completed forms TO YOUR AUDITION!

A sample *AUDITION FORM* is attached so that you can see what you can see how you will be evaluated! Please complete your information at the top and BRING TO YOUR AUDITION.

All students need to be in a completed *VMPA SIGN-UP FORM*. Bring to audition!!

Troubadour potential members must complete the *INFO & COMMITMENT FORM*, both sides. Parents and students must complete the Troubadour *PERMISSION TO AUDITION FORM* as well. Bring these (completed) to your audition! GET THEM SIGNED please!
